Fraud & Financial Exploitation	<p>Don Snoke presented on his personal experience with 3 estates;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Citibank - bait/switch on credit/loan rates & terms. Offered lower rate; switched to accounting technician, who signed up for lower payments, longer term of loan, actually paid more interest. 2. Retirement Account Advisor changed to Wells Fargo; Advisor Fee increased 3X; monthly statements increased from 8 pages to 70+ pages, with multiple fees charged. Estimated loss of \$100K x 10 years. 3. Social Security is NOT bankrupt. Provided historical presentation of Social Security Reform including The Greenspan Commission (1981) to the work of Lawrence Klein (who Don worked with directly) Economic Science Nobel Prize awarded 1980. Described the process for increasing contributions to SS by workers/ employers to ensure financial stability and viability for as long as needed; provided fund is not diverted for other uses.
