Major Reasons for Having an Updated Comprehensive Plan:

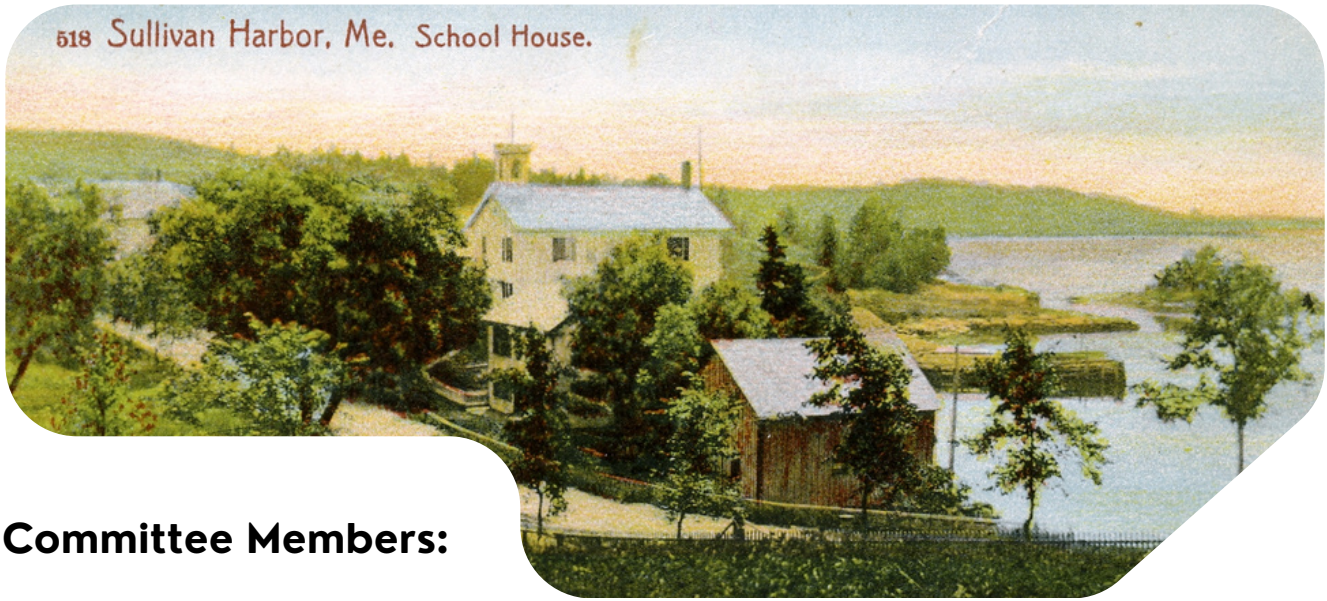
- Eligibility for federal, state, local, and private funding.

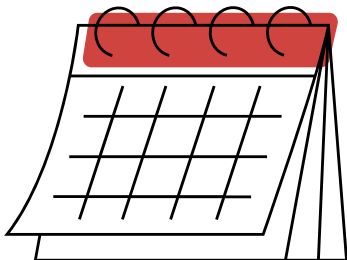
